Dear Shooters:

Here are the match results for the BORCC July IDPA Match. There were 30 registered shooters including five new shooters to our club; which was not bad for a match that was never scheduled and was shot on a National Holiday. Six demented participants went through the stages with a second firearm bring the grand total to 36 competitors. The breakdown of divisions was 9 SSP, 6 CDP, 9 ESP, 7 ESR, and 5 SSR. The stages were challenging. Alright, they went beyond my skill level. It was not the worst match I have ever shot. It is probably the second worst. Stage 1 with the windmill of death ate my face. Then I fell asleep in the tent, couldn't find my glasses and had to shoot with both eyes closed. At least that is what I told the SO when he asked me if I shot it with my eyes closed. The top shooter in CDP and overall lowest match time goes to Dan Gipe from Richland, MI. SSP was headed up by 6th overall Paul Haluda. Lee Fisher turned in the best two times in ESP and was 3rd and 4th overall. The wheel gunners have Pete White coming in 7th overall and 1st in ESR and Randy Ciesiolka coming in 1st and 2nd in SSR and finishing 5th and 8th overall for the match. BORCC's own Jack Cleminshaw actually had the lowest overall time for ESR but he was using non legal equipment (an 8 shot revolver with a competition holster carrying about 12 full moon clips right in front of his belly) and was not concealed carry which does not qualify him for placement in the match. I will give Jack honorable mention by coming in 2nd overall with a wheel gun and having the lowest time on Stage 6 [though I can not declare it the lowest time]. It was very impressive to watch. It was Jack who was SO when I fired the tent stage.

The club will be hosting the mid states area ICORE Match the weekend of July 17 & 18. This is a revolver only match and two firearm donated by Smith & Wesson and one from Ruger will be awarded at this match by random drawing. In previous events, first time shooters have gone home with a new bullet launcher. If you own a revolver (or know someone that will loan you one), you need to come to this match. It is not IDPA it is IPSC with a wheel gun.

The staff at BORCC hopes you enjoyed our little match and decide to make the first Sunday of the month a scheduled visit to our range. Our next scheduled IDPA match will be on August 1st. Traditionally the August match is the annual BUG Match. All stages will be five shot neutral. The entire match is designed to be shot with a five shot 2" J Frame revolver. The match may be shot with any firearm as the normal five divisions of semi autos and revolvers will be available. Only the BUG guns will be restricted to the five rounds loaded rule. If you own a snubby revolver, here is your opportunity to come out and play with it.

If anyone can inform me who designed and built the windmill, I will personally see to it they never ever design another piece of range equipment.
