Dear Shooters:

Here are the match results for the BORCC June IDPA Match. There were 30 registered shooters including five new match participants. The breakdown of divisions was 12 SSP, 8 CDP, 6 ESP, 1 SSR, and 3 ESR. The stages were different with an unusually large number of distant targets. Stage 3 with the shopping bag on your head ate me up. I never hit a target. The next time I see Tom Tiethoff from South Kent I am going to punch him in the face. The top shooter in SSP and overall lowest match time goes to BORCC's own Mike Gorbitz (this is no surprise, as Mike normally pounds us into the ground). CDP was headed up by 3<sup>rd</sup> overall Dan Gipe from Richland, MI. Brandon Everett turned in the lowest time in ESP and was 2<sup>nd</sup> overall. Brandon hales from Mattawan, MI. The wheel gunners have Tom Schwenk coming in 14<sup>th</sup> overall in ESR (using full moon clips). Tom receives honorable mention for turning in the lowest time on Stage 4 (the Sniper/Spotter course – another Tom Tiethoff design). Excellent shooting Tom. Did I mention that Tom is a FIP and resides in South Bend, IN ?

A reminder: we do not hold an IDPA match in July. It always falls on the Fourth of July weekend. The club will be hosting the mid states area ICORE Match the weekend of July 17 & 18. This is a revolver only match and two firearm donated by Smith & Wesson will be awarded at this match by random drawing. In previous events, first time shooters have gone home with a new bullet launcher. If you own a revolver (or know someone that will loan you one), you need to come to this match.

The staff at BORCC hopes you enjoyed our little match and decide to make the first Sunday of the month a scheduled visit to our range. Our next scheduled IDPA match will be on August 1<sup>st</sup>. Traditionally the August match is the annual BUG Match. All stages will be five shot neutral. The entire match is designed to be shot with a five shot 2" J Frame revolver. The match may be shot with any firearm as the normal five divisions of semi autos and revolvers will be available. Only the BUG guns will be restricted to the five rounds loaded rule. If you own a snubby revolver, here is your opportunity to come out and play with it.

# Course Design Descriptions

## Stage 1 Call Gone Bad

Starting with firearm in hand covering an intruder while talking to 911 dispatch. Fire two rounds on the close target, move to the wall to reload and engage a US Popper down range.

## Stage 2 Got To Go

Start sitting on the ground with firearm loaded between your legs. Retrieve the firearm and engage the three targets with two rounds each.

## Stage 3 Lights Out

Start with a shopping bag on your head. Need I say more?

## Stage 4 Sniper/Spotter

Start standing behind the drum. Using the drum for cover fire two rounds at each target (long shots).

## Stage 5 Trouble @ Allie's Pizza

Start standing behind a low wall. Engage the paper target, a US Popper and turning target. Move to the next wall and engage two paper, another US Popper and re-engage the turning target.

## Stage 6 Putt it in the Hole

Start with a golf club in your hands (life is too short to play golf – A golf course is the waste of a good rifle range). Hit the ball and engage five targets at increasing distance with 2 rounds each in tactical sequence and tactical priority.

## Stage 7 The combined rifle & pistol stage

Start behind a wall, engage three targets at extreme range. Move to the second wall and engage two close targets. Run a loooong way down range to a third wall and re-engage the three targets
