Shannan had the lowest time in CDP but was shooting her second firearm; therefore, the declared top shooter in CD and 4<sup>th</sup> overall for the match is BORCC's own JD Cleminshaw. The declared top shooter in SSP and 7<sup>th</sup> overall all is yours truly. Two other shooters had lower times; but alas, they were also shooting their second firearm. Our next match will be on Sunday February 5<sup>th</sup>, plan on being indoors. The staff at BORCC hopes the new shooters enjoyed the match and will make the first Sunday of the month IDPA Match a regular event on their social calendar.
